A question was received at the office this week in regards to the Holy Days of Obligation, so in case there are more parishioners wanting the information, please see below.

The Australian Catholic Bishops' Conference determined that, in addition to all the Sundays in the year, the only feast days to be observed in Australia as holy days of obligation are the solemnities of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ and the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Christmas Day (December 25 – the Feast of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ)

The Assumption (August 15 – the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary)
All Sundays of the year
