LENT

Pray + Fast + Give

During Lent, penance should not be only internal and individual but also external and social. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting and Abstinence from meat. On all other Fridays, except solemnities, the tradition of the common practice of penance is fulfilled by performing any one of the following:

(a) Prayer - eg, attending weekday Mass in addition to Sundays; family prayer; a visit to a church or chapel; reading the Bible; making the Stations of the Cross; praying the Rosary; or in other ways.

(b) Self-Denial - eg, not eating meat; not eating sweets or dessert; giving up entertainment to spend time with the family; limiting food and drink so as to give to the poor of one's own country or elsewhere; or in other ways. Project Compassion is a major means of expressing our self-denial in Australia.

(c) Helping Others - eg, special attention to someone who is poor, sick, elderly, lonely or over-burdened; or in other ways.

- All who have completed their 18th year and have not yet begun their 60th year are bound to fast. All who have completed their 14th year are bound to abstain.

- Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled between Ash Wednesday 22nd February and Trinity Sunday, 4th June 2023. This is in addition to the normal obligation to attend Mass every Sunday.

- The wonderful gift of the Lord's merciful love is offered in a special way in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Lent is a most appropriate time to receive this Sacrament. All the faithful who have reached the age of discretion are bound faithfully to confess their grave sins at least once a year.
