SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAM 2023

Please read carefully the following information

You will need to complete a separate registration form for <u>each Sacrament</u> your child is seeking to receive

Please note the <u>opening and closing registration dates</u> for each Sacrament program.

This is important since the parish needs to book suitable rooms and ensure that we have available Catechists.

This year our 2023 Sacramental program will include the parishes of Malvern and Malvern East.

Preparing children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and Holy Communion is primarily the responsibility of parents. This is a responsibility that all parents promise to undertake when their children are baptised as infants.

The most important part of your child's preparation for the sacraments is their regular participation in the Sunday Mass and your own example of regular worship, prayer and good works. All other preparation is secondary to that obligation of worshipping together each week with the Christian family gathered around the altar of God. Bringing your children to Mass regularly is an essential part of fulfilling the promises you made at your child's baptism to bring them up within the life of the church.

God's love and presence are made real and celebrated in the Sacraments. Important times and experiences in our lives are celebrated and enlivened by God's presence. Each Sacrament signifies, in a particular way, the transforming love of God and the new life which Jesus Christ brings.

Your parish is ready to assist you in this joyous responsibility of preparing your children for the Sacraments and, to this end, you and your children are invited to become fully involved in the ongoing life of your parish family in addition to the sacramental program offered for your children.

First Reconciliation is normally for children in Year 3 or above, and is celebrated in the 4th term.

First Communion is normally for children in Year 4 or above and is celebrated towards the end of the 2nd term.

Confirmation is normally for children in Years 5 and 6 or above and is celebrated towards the end of the 3rd term. The regional Bishop nominates the dates.

The Sacramental program is not a program at all – it is a 'sacramental journey' in which there needs to be a moment of discernment about when we are ready to receive the Sacrament and this has very little to do with age or school year level. It has more to do with the integration into the worshipping life of the parish community and our personal spiritual growth and prayer life.

TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD FOR SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION you must belong to either the Malvern or Malvern East Parish. If you belong to another Parish, please seek advice from your parish.

Please clearly fill out the enclosed registration form and email it to the Parish Office or hand it to the Parish Priest.

Registration is usually open 4-6 weeks prior to the nominated sacrament closing date for registration.

Commitment Masses

All children preparing for the Sacrament will be enrolled as candidates at Mass on the weekend of 14th / 15th October. They may attend any Mass at either parish church on this weekend. That is:

<u>Saturday</u> 14thOctober 5.00pm - Holy Eucharist; 6pm at St Joseph's, or <u>Sunday</u> 15th October 9.00am- St. Mary's; 10.00am – St Joseph'; 10.30am -Holy Eucharist

After-school Preparation Sessions

Preparation for all children **not attending** the Parish Primary School will include five after school sessions. The venue will be determined once numbers are finalized. Parents should be prepared to travel to either St Joseph's Malvern or St Mary's Malvern East. These sessions are an integral part of the preparation in receiving the Sacrament. **Students cannot receive the Sacrament if they have not attended 80% at these sessions.**

Home Activity Pack & Passport to Reconciliation

There will be a home-based course handed out at the Information Evening which requires parents to work together with their children as they prepare for the Sacrament. They will also receive a Sacramental Passport. The passport is to be presented to the priest after Mass on the Saturdays / Sundays between the information evening and receiving the Sacrament for his signature.

<u>St Joseph's Primary School children</u>: 22nd November at St Joseph's Church at 7pm.

Saturday 29th April 5.00pm - Holy Eucharist; 6pm at St Joseph's, or Sunday 30th April 9.00am - St. Mary's; 10.00am - St Joseph's; 10.30am - Holy Eucharist

After-school Preparation Sessions

Preparation for all children **not attending** the Parish Primary School will include 7 after school sessions. The venue will be determined once numbers are finalized. Parents should be prepared to travel to either St Joseph's Malvern or St Mary's Malvern East. There will be a home-based course handed out at the Information Evening which requires parents to work together with their children as they prepare for the Sacrament. They will also receive a Sacramental Passport. The passport is to be presented to the Priest at Mass between the information workshop and the date of receiving the Sacrament, for his signature.

<u>Children receiving 1st Communion at Holy Eucharist Malvern East</u>. 1st Communion will be held on Saturday, 17th June during the 5pm Mass.

<u>Children receiving 1st Communion at St Mary's Malvern East.</u> 1st Communion will be on Sunday, 18th June at a 12.00 midday Mass.

Each child wishing to prepare for the Sacrament is asked to personally hand the Registration Form to the Parish Priest after any Mass prior to close of registration.

For children receiving this sacrament at St Mary's Church rehearsal will be held at St Mary's Church at 6pm on Thursday 7th Sept. Bishop Anthony Ireland will confer this **Sacrament on Friday** 8th Sept during the 5pm Mass.

For children receiving this sacrament at **St Joseph's Church** a rehearsal will be held at St Joseph's Church at 6pm on Tuesday 12th Sept. Bishop Anthony Ireland will confer this Sacrament on Thursday 14th September during the 5pm Mass.

Families can nominate what confirmation date they would like.

These rehearsals will take 40 minutes.

Home Activity Pack & Passport to Confirmation

There will be a home-based course handed out at the Information Evening which requires parents to work together with their children as they prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. They will also receive a Sacramental Passport. The passport is to be presented to the Priest after Mass during the preparation period for his signature.

Overview of Sacramental Dates – 2023

It is important to register your child **BEFORE** the closing date for each sacrament, since we have limited placements. This is especially the case in regards to the Sacrament of Confirmation.

1st Communion:

- Holy Eucharist Church Malvern East Saturday 17th June during the 5pm Parish Mass
- St Joseph's Church Malvern Sunday 18th June during the 10am Parish Mass
- St Mary's Church Malvern East Sunday 18th June during the midday (12pm) additional Mass.

Candidates can nominate any above date for their 1st Communion. If these dates are not suitable please approach the parish priest to arrange a time.

Confirmation:

- St Mary's Church Malvern East Friday 8th September during the 5pm Mass
- St Joseph's Church Malvern Thursday 14th September during the 5pm Mass

<u>Please Note</u>: Bishop Anthony Ireland has nominated these dates and time for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Candidates will be invited to nominate the day they wish to be confirmed.

1st Reconciliation:

- St Joseph's Church Malvern Tuesday 21st November at 7pm
- St Mary's Church Malvern East Wednesday 22nd November at 7pm

If the Reconciliation date is not suitable, please approach a priest to arrange a time. Once the child has been prepared they can approach any priest, in any parish to receive this sacrament.
