Guidelines for Working With Children Checks

Corpus Christi Parish Volunteers ONLY

- 1. You need to have a valid email address. To apply for a Working With Children Check, go to https://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au
- 2. If the WWCC is requested by an organisation where you do voluntary work, tick 'volunteer,' this means you will not have to pay for the WWCC.
- 3. If you have used another name, including maiden surnames or aliases, these need to be listed in the section 'have you been known by another name.'
- 4. List your residential address and any other address where you have lived in the past five years.
- 5. Under organisation please write:

- 6. Under Occupational Work Code please select number: **64. Religious Organisations**.
- 7. The next screen is meant for you to check your details one last time before you submit.
- 8. In the next screen, you will need to tick the box at the bottom to indicate that you agree with what you have read.
- 9. Press print and take this sheet, together with a 100-point proof of identification, to a post office.

100-POINT IDENTIFICATION CHECK DOCUMENTS

Category A – each document is worth 70 points

Only one document from this category is accepted.

- Birth certificate (not an extract)
- Australian passport (current, or expired within the previous two years, but not cancelled)
- Australian citizenship certificate
- International passport (current, or expired within the previous two years, but not cancelled)
- Other identity document with the same characteristics as a passport e.g. diplomatic/refugee (photo or signature)

Category B – the first document is worth 40 points

- Current drivers licence or permit (government-issued)
- Working with children/teachers' registration card
- Aviation security identification card/maritime security identification card
- Public employee photo ID card (government-issued)
- Department of Veterans' Affairs card
- Centrelink pensioner concession card or health care card
- Current tertiary education institution photo ID
- Reference from a medical practitioner (who has known the individual for at least 12 months)

Category C – each document is worth 25 points

- Birth certificate extract
- Foreign/international driver's licence
- Proof of age card (government-issued)
- Medicare card/private health care card
- Council rates notice
- Property lease/rental agreement
- Property insurance papers
- Australian Tax Office assessment
- Superannuation statement
- Seniors card
- Electoral roll registration
- Motor vehicle registration or insurance documents
- Professional or trade association card
