We are facing unprecedented times...heartbreaking in fact, in so many

Given the seriousness of COVID-19 and the Government regulations put in place, the Bishops of the Province of Victoria have given prayerful and considered reflection and determined the following actions:

Immediate suspension of public liturgies, celebrations of the Mass and all other gatherings until further notice. In our Parish, this also applies to the Novena group, Our Lady's Prayer Group and the Italian Charismatic Group.

In light of this, all Catholics in Victoria are dispensed from their Sunday obligation until further notice (canon 1248).

- * However you are encouraged to continue active participation in the life of the Church, through activities such as personal and family prayer, reflecting on the Scriptures, making a spiritual communion, or participating in a Mass online (http://bit.ly/MassOnDemand OR https:// melbournecatholic.org.au/Mass **OR** www.wordonfire.org/daily-mass). For those without a computer, mass is also screened on Sundays at 6.00am on Channel 10 - Mass for you at Home.
- * Our Church will be open for private prayer. Please be mindful to follow the precautionary measures already in place especially regarding distancing and sanitizing hands.
- * We will keep you informed of updates via the weekly bulletin which will continue to be published and will be available from Saturday mornings in the Fovers of the Church.
- * There will also be updates via the Parish webpage at stmhadfield.org.au.
- * The Parish Office will be open during parish office hours but if there is no one in attendance please leave a message and your call will be returned as soon as possible.
- * I will be offering daily Mass (privately) and will be praying for you all and for your intentions. If you wish for me to pray for a deceased loved one, you may drop your prayer/mass request in the parish letter box. Names will continue to be published in the Parish bulletin.
- *These are trying times for everyone, but I request that, where possible, you continue to support your Church. For those contributing to Thanksgiving you may wish to drop your envelopes in the Parish letterbox alternatively a box will be set up in the middle of the Altar to drop off your Thanksgiving envelopes or your donations to the Church. If you wish to contribute on line, please contact the Parish Office.

Let us not panic, nor be anxious, nor think only of ourselves. This is a time to be sensible, practical, prayerful and to share Christ's peace with those who are struggling to feel calm and safe.
