The Ascension of the Lord Yr A - 23rd & 24th May 2020



Each Sunday we profess through the Creed, "He ascended into Heaven." Christ's Ascension was the culmination of God's divine plan for Christ Jesus, his return to his Father with "Mission Accomplished." The Ascension, as the grand finale of all Jesus' words and works done for us and for

our salvation, is a culmination, but not a conclusion. Jesus is now with God in glory, and with us in the Holy Spirit: "Lo, I am with you always".

The feast of the Ascension celebrates one aspect of the Resurrection, namely Jesus' exaltation. He did not wait 40 days to be glorified at God's right hand. That had already happened at his Resurrection. Like the 40 days after Easter during which He appeared to many in Israel, this public Ascension into Heaven was given to us for our sakes. The forty days allowed many to experience personally Jesus' Resurrection from the dead and his being alive in a glorified body as fact to be counted upon, reality, and the fulfillment of prophecy.

The focus of this feast is the Heavenly reign of Christ, and the Lord's being "seated at God's right hand," meaning He alone will be in control of the continuing plan of salvation through the Holy Spirit, unrestricted by time, space or culture. It is there, at the "right hand of God," that Jesus continues to make intercession for all of us with the Father. Thus, the Paschal Mystery — Jesus' passion, death, Resurrection, Ascension and the sending of the Holy Spirit — is a single, unbroken Reality which is to be understood by Faith. By His Ascension, Jesus, the risen Christ, True God and True Man, is One with the Father and the Holy Spirit in glory forever. (Excerpts from cbci homilies)

As Christians, we need to be **proclaimers and evangelizers**. The difference between preaching and proclaiming is that we **preach with words**, but we **proclaim with our lives**. Let us ask the guidance of the Holy Spirit that we may bear witness to Jesus by our transparent Christian lives which we also hope to share.

Bishops announce gradual re-opening of churches ...

Last week, it was announced that churches in Victoria may begin to re-open for small gatherings and private prayer. Every parish is different and they must assess what is reasonably possible within their local community and within the guidelines. Churches may be re-opened but there must be provision for the collection of contact details, strict monitoring of numbers, ongoing hygiene requirements, publicising the scheduled times for private worship, and a limit of 10 people for public worship.

For this reason, our Parish Church was open this week for private prayer only. Thank you to all the parishioners that came and adhered and cooperated with all the regulations put into place.

However I am confident that we can move to the next step and begin to celebrate Masses during the three weekdays Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Therefore effective Tuesday 26th May (until further notice)...

- 1. The Church will be open for 9.15am Mass on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Church doors will open at 9.00am and close at 10.00am.
- 2. Maximum attendance at any Mass is 10 people.
- 3. Frequency of attendance at Mass per person will depend on how many people pre-register (participation at Mass may be weekly, fortnightly or less frequently)
- 4. Attendance is <u>only by pre-registration</u> by email to admin@stmhadfield.org.au or by calling the Parish Office during office hours on 93571422, or ringing Viviana on 0402 249 117. You will receive a confirmation of your Mass booking date. If you are unable to attend on your booked day, then please contact the Parish Office by phone or email, so your spot can be passed on to another parishioner.

Please do not try to attend any Mass unless registration is confirmed beforehand.
