On the large bead before each decade

On the ten small beads of each decade

Celebrant: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, All: Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

After the five decades

Conclude with

All: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on

us and on the whole world. (Three times)

Celebrant: Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
