REFLECTION

Had Elijah not first endured a mighty wind, an earthquake and fire he may not have recognized the presence of the Lord in the gentle breeze. Similarly, the disciples battling a heavy sea, confused Jesus for a ghost, watched Peter sinking as he tried to walk across the water then saw Jesus put out his hand to hold him. Then the wind dropped. Without the storm we do not always appreciate the provider of calm. In the letter to the Romans, Paul acknowledges that in following Christ he remained of Jewish 'flesh and blood' and affirmed his people's unique heritage, their special place in salvation history. Whenever the followers of Christ have forgotten the Jewish origins of their faith, prejudice, oppression and appalling atrocities towards Jews have followed. When our prayer is the same as Peter's, "Lord, save me', we should remember that the hand that rescued Peter was a Jewish hand.
