"Promise, Pledge & Repent" Reflection 3rd Sunday of Lent

Lent is a call to weep for what we could have been and are not. Lent is the grace to grieve for what we should have done and have not. Lent is an opportunity to change what we ought to change, but have not.

Lent is not about penance. Lent is about becoming, doing and changing whatever it is that is blocking the fullness of life in us right now.

Today's responsorial psalm speaks of God's law as refreshment for our journey through life. The law of God revives the soul; it gladdens the heart and brings light to the eyes.

God's law is not an onerous duty or a burden. it frees us to be everything we are created to be.

Do we think of God's word as refreshing? We can sometimes experience law as a burden imposed that restricts our enjoyment of life. Laws formulated by humans can have these characteristics but not the law of God. This law, expressed in the Ten Commandments and in Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, reveals the wisdom and love of God for all. If we are faithful to this law we will be at rights with God. and in harmony with our fellow beings.
