The Transfiguration of the Lord 6th August 2023 Issue No 27

This weekend we focus on the Transfiguration of the Lord.

The transfiguration of the Lord is a profound event that continues to hold great significance for us today. It serves as a powerful reflection on the divinity and transformative power of Jesus Christ.


