THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Signs of the Messiah

Jesus tells the disciples of John the Baptist to report to the prophet who is in prison that the One whom he baptised in the River Jordan, with the Holy Spirit descending on him in the form of a dove, is truly the Messiah. They do not have to look for another. The proofs can be seen in the blind regaining their sight, the lame walking, and the sick being healed. These are the signs of the presence of the Messiah and the coming of God's kingdom. These miracles and the proclamation of the kingdom should be sufficient to comfort John in his cell in Macherus. His efforts to prepare for the coming of the messiah have not been in vain.

The prophet Isaiah (First Reading) exhorts the Israelites to rejoice because the Lord himself is coming to bring salvation to his people. His presence will put an end to oppression. He will restore justice on earth.

In the Gospel, Jesus is working round the clock. He fulfils the prophecy of Isaiah, bringing healing to the lame, the blind, the lepers, and many other sick people.

The Second Reading teaches the Christians to be patient over the delay of the Lord's second coming. Christians should not become irritable.

If we cannot wait patiently, we will be sorry forever. There will be no joy in our hearts. Even if the Lord comes, his coming will have no meaning for us.

December 15th, 2019 - 3rd Sunday of Advent

Today's readings and prayers help us focus on the joy that is within the Advent season. Christians are called to embody the joy that comes from encountering Christ. Pope Francis writes in The Joy of the Gospel that "the Gospel, radiant with the glory of Christ's cross, constantly invites us to rejoice". After all, the Pope writes in the exhortation, even amid persecution, the disciples were filled with joy. "Why should we not also enter into this great stream of joy?" the Holy Father asks.
