REFLECTION

"My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; My spirit rejoices in God my saviour. For he has looked upon his handmaid's lowliness; Behold, from now on will all ages call me blessed. The Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name. His mercy is from age to age to those who fear him. He has might with his dispersed the arrogant of mind and



heart. He has thrown down the rulers from their thrones, but lifted up the lowly. The hungry he has filled with good things; the rich he has sent away empty. He has helped Israel his servant, remembering his mercy, according to his promise to our fathers,

to Abraham and to his descendants forever." Amen. Amen. Amen.

Can I spend a little time each day this week, standing or sitting in place with Mary & Elizabeth, younger & older cousins: both pregnant, the one previously rejected as "barren", the other perhaps to be rejected as an "unbetrothed" mother; the one whose child in utero "leapt for joy that the Mother of my Saviour should come to me", the other to be told within months that "your child is destined for the fall & the rising of many, to be a sign that is rejected - & a sword will pierce your own soul." And perhaps taking time to remember also the dumbfounded Zachary as he is able to rejoice in full restored voice at the birth of his son, John; and of Joseph who was told, "Do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, she has conceived what is in her by the Holy Spirit...she will give birth to a son & you must name him Jesus - for he is the one to save his people...". Contrary to the style of the time (& even now for many) neither man is to the fore but is the faithful & faith-filled companion husband & honourable loving father to be. Sitting with this foursome may help us reflect on our hurly burly, hurried world and the space for our own response; & perhaps even encourage our prayer for the their ancient land, again in seemingly unending torment. Let us pray.
