CAN WE EVER DOUBT?

In 1936 Edward VIII was crowned King of England. He was 41 years old and was still a bachelor. In those days, England still had many colonies: India, Burma, Malaysia, Singapore, Borneo, Nigeria, Ghana, Rhodesia, and still others.

England was a superpower - and Edward VIII was its king.

But Edward VIII loved Wallis Simpson, a divorced woman, and such a marriage was forbidden to him. But after eleven months as king, Edward resigned from his kingship, stepped down from the throne, removed his crown and diamonds and married Wallis Simpson in another religion.

Some people pitied Edward - but Edward said, "If I had two kingdoms I would gladly give up both of them for the woman I love."

Did Wallis Simpson ever doubt Edward's love for her? I do not know. But if she doubted - all she would have to do to remove her doubts was to recall what Edward had given up for her.

Wouldn't it be nice if somebody gave up a kingdom for us? If somebody did that for us we could never doubt that person's love for us - could we?

But, in truth, somebody has given up a kingdom for us. Jesus, who was seated at the right hand of his Father, left his throne and crown, dismissed the angels surrounding him - and became a child, born in a stable for you and for me. Isn't that true?

Can we ever doubt his love for us? Come what may: sickness, failure, even death - after what he had done for us - after what he continues to do for us - after promising that he is now preparing a mansion for us - can we ever doubt the love for our Lord and our King Jesus Christ?




NEW PROJECTOR
