Reflection

IS IT NOT ENOUGH


Whenever I read the gospel which was read today (Luke 13:22-30) it frightens us into examining our lives. Jesus tells us that the master of the house will lock the door and that those standing outside will say, "Sir, open the door," but the master will say, "I do not know you!"

Then outside will say, "We ate and drank in your company. You taught in our streets, "but the master will say, "I tell you, I do not know you! I do not know you! It's frightening, isn't it?

Jesus is telling us if we say to Jesus, "Oh Jesus, I have been a Catholic my whole life. My wife is a Catholic. She goes to Church every Sunday and says the rosary every night. My children go to Catholic schools. At Christmas and Easter, when I go to Church, I'm extra generous in putting money in the collection." And the master will say, I do not know you!"

"Oh Jesus, I was married in the Church. Sometimes I watch the procession. I have never stepped inside a Protestant church. I still remember the 'Oh, my God, I am heartily sorry.... "And the master will say, I do not know you!"

Is such a thing possible? It is. It's frightening, isn't it? I hope so.

If you need to dispose of a vehicle either from a deceased estate or which is no longer required, please consider gifting it to the "Lifeboat Geelong Foundation", a registered charity with tax deductible status which for nine years has been providing pastoral and practical support to nearly 150 victims / survivors of church-related sexual abuse

Many of these suffer post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and have limited or no employment. A donated vehicle could vastly improve their quality of life.
