A Reflection for the 25th Sunday

Jesus took a little child, setting him in front of the Twelve, put his arms around him and said to them,

"Whoever welcomes one of these little children in my name, welcomes me; and anyone who welcomes me, welcomes not me but the one who sent me."

Mark 9.37

Jesus said, Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

"The test of a morality of a society is what it does for its children." Dietrich Bonhoeffer, 1906-1945

If we take Jesus seriously, each child is a Godbearer; too often our society, including Church, has discounted or trivialized children despite their intrinsic worth as images and pathways to knowing God. We should also remember our faithful priests, in our prayer and support, often hurt by the wilful actions of one-time confreres or leaders and so often battered in public opinion. And we might also encourage those who might hesitate about becoming or remaining Catholic that we ordinary People of God are the essential Church.

We are baptised not into an institution but into a relationship with Jesus, who reminds us, "I am with you always."

And let us pray for one another.
