Refection

Wounds from a friend can hurt much more than those from an enemy.

It's the kind of pain that cuts deep.
It's a wound that aches and throbs and is slow to heal.

The rejection's unexpected, and therefore worse — more painful.

We've all experienced rejection at some point in our lives. Whether it's being picked last for a game at recess or being turned down for a job or being ridiculed for our faith, rejection from anyone hurts. But rejection at the hand of a friend hurts even more.

And, the deeper the friendship, the more excruciating the pain.

There is one thing that brings us hope in the midst of any rejection:

Our Savior was rejected, too — even by his closest friends.

The rejection Jesus endured shows us that he is our perfect forever faithful friend. His love for us is not fickle. It's not dependent upon what we do for him, and it does not change.

As long as we live, we will all experience rejection — even from dear friends whom we have loved and trusted for years. Jesus never promised to protect us from pain or sorrow, but to be with us in it and eventually to deliver us through it to himself.
