# Reflection IN THE BEGINNING THERE WAS LOVE

- I have loved you with everlasting love.
  (Jeremiah 31:3)
- Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne?
   Though she may forget, I will not forget you!
   See, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands. (Isaiah 49:15)
- This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son.(1 John 4:10)
- God chose us in Christ before the world was made. (Ephesians 1:4)
- Nothing can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord....(Romans 8:39)

The first and most enduring word in our life of faith is the Father's everlasting love. This is what he is continuously saying to us and what we fathom in all he does for us each day: I love you.
