TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR C

Jesus' teaching and miracles have been attracting crowds of would-be followers. In today's Gospel Jesus challenges His disciples with the notion that discipleship comes at a cost. It's all very well to go with the crowd when the miracle-worker is in town and gaining popularity, but have these followers considered the consequences? Jesus speaks of the utter commitment needed to be a disciple. Jesus sets out a clear 'black or white' extreme position. To 'love' Jesus means 'hating' all else.

The Gospel, Luke 14:25-33, contains some of the most demanding utterances attributed to Jesus in the New Testament. Certainly, the concluding statement, 'None of you can be my disciple unless he or she gives up all possessions', is the most extreme statement on renunciation of wealth in the Gospel of Luke

In a sense, what Jesus is doing in the Gospel is simply being honest with his disciples. He foresees that those who follow him will inevitably become caught up in the suffering and death he now sees to lie ahead of him. It is no kindness to followers to keep them in ignorance of this. He must prick any illusions they have about where following him might lead.

In a world which spends millions on advertising and promoting products and causes, Jesus' words sound very strange. Far from advertising discipleship, his words sound discouraging. 'Take up your Cross' is hardly a caption that would sell Christianity. But this is just the point. Jesus isn't after half-hearted followers. He wants 'all or nothing' Christians, people who know what they are taking on and give a whole-hearted commitment.

Safeguarding Essentials Online Training

The long-awaited *Safeguarding Essentials* online training module, for all clergy and volunteers is available.

Safeguarding Essentials is a 30-minute online training module for all clergy and volunteers within the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne.

This accessible and engaging resource provides clergy and volunteers with foundational knowledge and a clear understanding of their duty of care and expectations in relation to safeguarding children, young people and vulnerable persons from all forms of abuse and harm.

- This will be an annual requirement for everyone to complete individually online.
- At the completion of the training participants will receive a certificate of completion, and the parish will be sent notification that the module has been completed successfully.

How to access the training

To access the online training go to: www.safeguarding.melbournecatholic.org To login, each volunteer or clergy member will need:

- Working with Children Check ID
- Email address.

To register, volunteers will need to select their parish [Mooroolbark] from the dropdown menu as their Primary Organisation of Service.

You will need to have an up to date browser.

The WWCC ID is used to record who has registered and successfully completed the training. Participants' privacy is protected in accordance with the <u>CAM Privacy Policy</u>.

All volunteers are required to complete this training annually. If needing help the office will be able to assist.
