LECTIO DIVINA

Read: Ezekiel makes it clear that our lives are not determined by a single choice. Each day we decide anew if we will obey God's commandments and live justly or not. Each day we choose the path of life or the path of death. Jesus' parable reminds us that each moment of our life is a new opportunity to follow him. Paul's letter to the Philippians describes the life of a disciple: living in unity, caring for each other, and loving selflessly.

Reflect: Riding in the highway, I see signs announcing, "Last exit before toll" or "last fuel for seventy-five miles." We're always on the lookout for last chances. Jesus' parable in today's Gospel reminds us that, as long as we are alive, we can always turn back to the Lord and seek holiness. Good intentions are not enough. We need to take action, turning away from sin and pursuing holiness. It is easy to say that we want to be good, pray more, love wholeheartedly, but it is much harder to put action behind these words.

Pray: Lord, help me to do the things I need to do to grow closer to you.

Act: Choose one spiritual goal and so something to put it into practice.
