The **Plenary Council 2020** moves into its next phase - Listening and Discernment.

Continuing the journey to the Plenary Council

As you may be aware, the Listening and Dialogue phase of the Plenary Council has now concluded and we are moving into a period of Listening and Discernment. During this phase, we continue to seek the wisdom of the Holy Spirit as we discern how we can best respond to how God is calling us to be a Christ-centred Church in Australia.

1. The National Themes for Discernment

There are six national themes for discernment. How is God calling us to be a Christ-centred Church in Australia that is:

- •
- missionary and evangelising?
- inclusive, participatory and synodal?
- prayerful and Eucharistic?
- humble, healing and merciful?
- a joyful, hope-filled and servant community?
- open to conversion renewal and reform?

2. Information about the National Themes for Discernment

There are two key reports available to parishes and individuals who wish to learn more about each of the themes:

- Each theme has a 'snapshot dialogue' report, which provides a sample of the voices and answers that inspired the theme.
- The final report for the Listening and Dialogue phase contains a more detailed overview of each theme, more examples of the issues that were raised, detail about the research process and so on.
