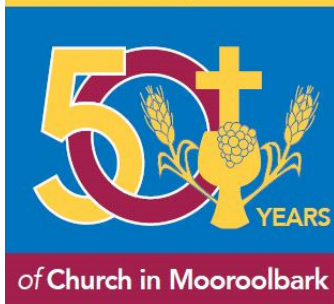

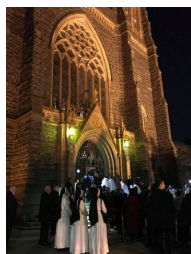
To prepare the agenda for the Plenary Council, all of God’s people are invited to reflect on the question **“What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?”**

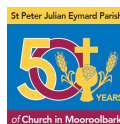
