Gospel Reflection:

The joy that underlies Advent the Season blooms like a rose. coming to prominence on this the third Sunday of Advent. Today we are celebrating Gaudete Sunday, meaning 'joy'. It signified by the is lighting of the rose candle. colour the representing joyfulness.

Joy is brimming over



in today's readings. Isaiah's upbeat and inspirational passage expresses a joyous vision of a new creation. This prophecy indicating that God is coming to do great things is made manifest in the presence of Jesus himself and in his response to the disciples of John the Baptist-"the blind see again, and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised to life and the Good News is proclaimed to the poor." Christ alone has the power to heal and restore life. In his presence creation is revived, and so in the blossoming of the wilderness and the desert.

At a time of the year when many people are frantically busy with end-of-year functions, Christmas parties, last minute shopping for gifts and preparing for Christmas meals, the writer of James calls for patience. Waiting patiently for the Lord's Coming challenges us as to how we live now: it must make a difference, a difference in attitude, in kindness, forgiveness and love: "Do not make complaints against one another."

As Christmas fast approaches let us continue to blossom as disciples of Christ, rejoicing in the knowledge that the Lord our God is near.
