

## **Gospel Reflection:**

Today's gospel follows last week's encounter that Peter had with Jesus whereby Peter falls into the water due to his lack of faith. The gospel writer Matthew contrasts this Canaanite woman Peter. She is an outsider and hasn't had the privilege to spend as much time with Jesus as Peter had. She goes by the



stories that others have shared about what Jesus has done, about all the healings and the news about his Father's love and she believes. She has a faith that is persistent, vigorous and confident in God's faithfulness to God's promises.

Isn't this our story? None of us have walked along side Jesus like Peter did but we have heard his stories and witnessed how Jesus has touched other people's lives. We may feel at times unworthy of God's love and feel like a house dog but we have a guarantee that God doesn't look upon us that way. Even if we have lapsed in our conviction of faith in God, God has not lost his faith in us.

In our lives, we expect certain people to be our guides and to teach and inspire us and so we might miss the unexpected grace and inspiration from encounters we might choose to ignore. Let's not limit hospitality to those who we know and just offer the scraps from our table of hospitality to others when we could perhaps give a bit more of ourselves? How can we do this better? How can we do it this week (even in our lockdown situation)? Jesus grew in his humanity and learnt from the woman. The woman grew in her faith and learnt from Jesus. Let's keep learning from the wise people around us and from the greatest teacher of them all!
