### **Gospel Reflection:**

Today's gospel is Matthew's conclusion of Jesus' address to the disciples, we hear about final judgement and about Jesus Christ as Our King. The gospel flows on nicely from last week's where we are taught that the gifts we have been given are to be used for the service of others. Let us make no mistake **WE ALL HAVE TALENTS or GIFTS.** What are they?

Jesus Christ Our King gives us a very clear picture of what some of our gifts are. "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you made me welcome" etc. Then the upright will say to him in reply, "Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and make you welcome?" Jesus finishes with telling the disciples that if you do these things to another you do them to me.

So, what are your gifts? Perhaps it's time to shake off the old Catholic guilt about pride and humility. We all should be able to own and name the gift our good and generous God has given us. I am compassionate, I love to share my time with others and I am generous with my time, I have a good sense of fun, I have a great sense of justice and always try to speak for those who have no voice. I try to welcome the stranger. It is with a very grateful heart I thank our God for gracing me with these gifts.



It is not humility to hide these gifts given by God, for they are given to me and to you to use in the service of others, and when we do so it fills our God's heart with great joy. We only lack humility when we do not acknowledge our generous God for gifts given.

Name your gifts, own them, then use your gifts and *thank God for your gifts!*

Dear Parishioners,

20th November 2020

This weekend's Feast of Christ the King signals the end of the church's liturgical year whereby we say farewell to the gospels of Matthew and welcome the gospels of Mark. I think that many of us are looking to elements of 2020 ending so we begin with the church's liturgical year.

This also signals the end of our weekly pre-recorded masses. This service has been offered since March and here we are in November! I am indebted to the wonderful Hamish Dun who has tirelessly filmed and edited the mass for our viewing. St. Bede's college employs Hamish as an IT trainee. I thank John Finn, principal of St. Bede's for allowing Hamish to incorporate the filming of mass as part of his weekly duties. Hamish will be involved in the two pre-recorded Christmas masses.

Our live streaming efforts are underway and yes, the quality will not be as high as what you have been viewing but bear with us, as we will continue to enhance the live streaming masses. If anyone out there can assist with enhancing the live streaming masses then please contact me.

Advent begins next weekend. For those free on a Tuesday morning, Bernadette Carr is offering weekly reflections at 11am at St. Louis'. The Advent reflection book is also available for purchase from the parish office. \$5.

I am anticipating that the announcement on Sunday by the Premier will mean that we will move from having 20 people in the church to a 4 square meter ruling which will allow 57 people at St. Louis' and 73 at St. Brigid's. Therefore weekday masses probably do not need you to pre book but we still need to record details of all those who attend so booking can streamline that process. However, you definitely need to book for weekend masses. I am so looking forward to seeing more people at church!



Our two St Vincent de Paul conferences will use these donations to make up hampers to distribute to needy families in this area.


Donations can be left under the Christmas Tree if you are coming to one of our Masses or during the week they can be left at the Parish Office at St Louis or at St Brigid's School.


