2nd Sunday of Easter - Year C - 27th & 28th April 2019

Our readings for this week are ACTS 5: 12-16; APOCALYSE 1: 9-13, 17-19; JOHN 20: 19-31

Gospel Deflection:

John's gospel speaks to us today – firstly in the very clear message of our mission as followers of Christ 'As the Father sent me, so am I sending you.' 'Receive the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained.' and secondly in Christ's response to Thomas 'You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe.

Pope Francis connected these two concepts together. In his morning meditation in the Chapel of the Domus Sancte Marthae, (3rd July, 2013), he stated 'How can I find the wounds of Jesus today? I cannot see them as Thomas saw them. I find them in doing works of mercy, in giving to the body — to the body and to the soul, but I stress the body — of your injured brethren, for they are hungry, thirsty, naked, humiliated, slaves, in prison, in hospital. These are the wounds of Jesus in our day'

"What Jesus asks us to do with our works of mercy", the Pope concluded, "is what Thomas asked: to enter his wounds".

With the Holy Spirit, we are called to go out to give the good news as Jesus did. But how do we do this? Pope Francis says that in the works of mercy we extend to others, we are treating the wounds of Christ. And at the same time we are overcoming our doubts and strengthening our faith "The Risen Jesus passed on to his Church, as her first task, his own mission of bringing to all the concrete message of forgiveness. This is the first task: to announce forgiveness. This visible sign of his mercy brings with it peace of heart and joy of the renewed encounter with the Lord" (Pope Francis, Regina Caeli, April 23, 2017).

This is not always an easy task, particularly in the current time where acts of terror, like those of Christ Church and Sri Lanka, violence within our communities and families, discrimination, illness, and enduring hunger put our faith to the test.

"And yet, Easter reminds us that there is something more powerful than suffering and death: the love of the God who, in Christ, has taken upon himself our broken humanity." (Brother Silas Henderson, SDS | Apr 07, 2018) 'But when faith is lived and shown in service to others, then many doubts vanish because we feel the presence

of God and the truth of the Gospel in the love that, by no merit of ours, lives in us and that we share with others' (Pope Francis 23rd Nov 2016)

If we work with the Spirit to share the mission of Christ, our doubts are overwhelmed by the love of God and we share that love with all those we meet and it through these relationships that we encounter the Risen Christ and Jodie Marziano can like Thomas exclaim 'My Lord and my God!'
