
Gospel Reflection:

The powerful theme running through today's Gospel is one of hope, faith and trust in God. Let your heart not be troubled.

The disciples had reason to be concerned. Jesus had told them that one of them was a traitor. He indicated that HE would leave them that night. Even though Jesus knew the disciples were concerned he told them **'Let your heart not be troubled.'**

Jesus never wanted our lives to be without trouble but HE promised we could have an untroubled heart even in a troubled life. Instead of giving into that troubled heart Jesus firmly stated that they needed to put their trust in God and in Jesus himself. He promised that doing this would bring them contentment and peace.

As each day passes, we can become very comfortable in our lives, we can take people and events for granted, we can focus on the little things that annoy us in our families and we can become complacent in developing and maintaining our faith relationship with Jesus. The words of the Gospel are asking us to see the bigger picture 'Don't worry! You trust in God, trust also in me'. This is pertinent to the challenging circumstances we find ourselves in during the COVID-19 pandemic. It is now that God's words are there to inspire, sustain and encourage us. 
Parish Bulletins: For parishioners who are unable to access the internet and our website there are copies of the weekly Parish Bulletin available on the doors of both our Churches.
