Gospel Reflection:

A number of years ago I attended a women's retreat and the gospel we focused on was this week's gospel - the story of Mary and Martha. Like many of you, I had heard this gospel many times but this retreat opened this story for me in a way that was new to me. We were asked to reflect on the roles of Mary and Martha and turn that to our own lives- when are we like Martha? When are we like Mary? We debated the message of the gospel, which on the surface seems to be placing the listening of Mary ahead of the hospitality of Martha. But it's not as simple as that. Both Mary and Martha are disciples of Jesus and are showing their dedication through their service (Martha) and listening to Jesus (Mary).

Jesus in rebuking Martha, 'Martha, Martha,' he said, 'you worry and fret about so many things, and yet few are needed, indeed only one. It is Mary who has chosen the better part; it is not to be taken from her.' Jesus is not downplaying the hospitality that Martha is providing to



him as her guest but enlightening her to the priority at the time, to be in his presence and listening to his teaching The teaching of the gospel is that one thing is absolutely necessary to welcome the person of Jesus, to listen to his teaching and make it part of our lives. As Dianne Bergant CSA in her commentary on the gospel states that while Mary chose the right path by listening to Jesus, "This attentiveness will eventually express itself in appropriate service." 
