Gospel Reflection:

We often have times where we are looking for space to breathe, relax and take time out. We see on the news the paparazzi who chase down the famous and infamous people to take photos, even invade their privacy. Jesus did not have to deal with the paparazzi, although word of his ministry had grown and the crowds were eager to seek him out.

Capernaum was the town that Jesus lived in. He had moved from Nazareth and there were other disciples who lived here. Having been in Capernaum only a few months ago, I think back to how close the houses were built. To have a large

crowd arrive would have been challenging both for the crowd and those who lived in the town. There is an almost childlike comment made by the crowds, "**Rabbi**, when did you come here?". It seems



to come across as a wondering, how long had Jesus been back there before they had arrived.

Jesus, although probably wanting to rest, does not turn the crowds away, yet he does not tell them what they want to hear. In the Gospel Jesus tells the crowd that they are not looking for him, rather they are looking for the nourishment of God.

In our busy lives we too are often spending a lot of time chasing what is already available to us. We remember that God is with us, we just need to open our minds, open our ears and open our hearts that we might hear and feel the saving message for us. **Philip Hills**

All volunteers in our two Parishes are required to have a current Working With Children Check.






