19th Ordinary Sunday - Year C - 10th & 11th August 2019

Our readings for this week are WISDOM 18: 6-9; HEBREWS 11: 1-2, 8-19; LUKE 12: 32-48

Gospel Reflection:

Jesus said to his disciples: 'See that you are dressed for action and have your lamps lit.' In others words 'Don't go fumbling around in the dark for looking for oil to light your lamps, have it lit, ready. Don't go rummaging in the dark half asleep trying to dress yourself, have your clothes on ready to jump ready to go.' I can remember many years ago when we were going to leave at 4.00am in the morning to drive to Queensland, I told the kids they could sleep in their clothes because, it would be far quicker than trying to wake four sleepy kids and get them dressed so early in the morning.

Today we celebrate the feast day of our Parish Saint, Saint Mary of the Cross! Was Mary prepared to take on supporting her mother and brothers and sisters when her father left? Now, how could anyone be ready for that? Was Mary ready for everything that came her way, as opposition to how she believed the order should be formed? I don't think so. Was she ready for difficult times that some bishops of the time gave her? I doubt it. Was she ready for ill health that made her life very difficult? I don't think so. Was she ready for the fall out Mary had with Fr Julian Woods (Mary's co-founder of the Sisters of St Joseph)? No, definitely not.



Mary may not have anticipated most of the difficult things that came her way, however Mary MacKillop, this ordinary woman from Fitzroy, achieved many extraordinary things in her life, and all because her heart was set on God. Mary was in a sense, ready for what came her way, because of the great love she had for Jesus of the Gospels. Mary was a real Gospel woman. She was ready to walk in the footsteps of Jesus no matter the obstacles that came her way. St Mary of the Cross was ready to help the stranger, to share her food with the poor, even when she had so little herself. Mary was ready to care for the Sisters of St Joseph, and she did so like they were her own children. She taught the poorest of the poor and set up many schools in the outback of Australia where there were no schools. She opened homes for young women who struggled with making an honourable living. Mary's heart was always ready, because she knew that God was with her! Yes, she recognised God in the good stuff that happened, but she felt God close beside her in the many hardships that came her way. Mary cherished her relationship with God above all else, her faithfulness and trust in God drew her deeper into a familiar, loving relationship with God. Bernadette Carr


