# 19th Ordinary Sunday - Year B – 11th & 12th August 2018

Our readings for this week are: 1 KINGS 19:4-8, EPHESIANS 4:30-5:2, JOHN 6:41-51

# **Gospel Reflection:**

As an Easter people, we celebrate the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We are called to embrace the Paschal Mystery and live our lives imitating Jesus' example of finding life where there is death, light where there is darkness, hope where there is despair. Certainly, in the first reading, Elijah has come to a turning point in his life and all is looking bleak. He questions his life and struggles to find meaning. He is ready to meet his Maker but the only concern is that his Maker is not ready to meet him.

None of us are immune from the tough times and sadness that comes our way. Unlike Elijah's initial response, we are called to persist in seeing the life, light and hope that is just beyond. Hopefully others will be of assistance at these times.

A hope-filled occasion this weekend is the special Rite of Acceptance that is embedded into the 8am mass this Sunday. This marks the beginning of the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) process for six adults who are seeking to join our faith community fully next Easter. We welcome Olga, Matt, Steve, Robert, Shannon and Jo who will have the sign of cross marked out on their foreheads, eyes, ears, lips, shoulders, hands, feet and heart to symbolize that they are now invited to embrace the cross in their lives and see beyond the cross to the resurrection. As the psalm response echoes, our friends are invited to "taste and see the goodness of the Lord" that reaches its ultimate expression in the Eucharist, the "Bread of Life" as the Gospel writer John has been reminding us these last few weeks.
