# **Gospel Reflection:**

I'm still on a high from last week's special celebrations for the Feast of Mary of the Cross. There was so much joy and happiness in the hall from the moment the mass began to when we cleaned up and closed the hall. I'm indebted to so many people who came on board and assisted with the planning and success of the day. To me it was a symbol of how we can come together as a community regardless of whether we attend St. Louis church or St. Brigid's church or whether we are parents with children at either Catholic school or parents with children at other local schools.
