
Our readings for this week are: JOSHUA 24: 1-2, 15-18; EPHESIANS 5: 21-32; JOHN 6: 60-69

Gospel Reflection:

I am writing this reflection as I look forward to having dinner with my good friend Brian Collins. Brian was ordained a priest 25 years ago and tonight a large group of us will be sharing just a little more than bread and wine for dinner.

As I reflect on the gospel reading for today I wonder, how it was for Brian when he was summoned and given authority over unclean spirits. During this time in our church's history, we have to deal with the aftermath of the many very wrong doings against our children and vulnerable adults and perhaps some would say a lack of compassionate response by our church. Well, how

These men have been true shepherds, to the sheep in their flock, they have not always been listened to or agreed with, but they have continued the Gospel work God called them to all those years ago. 
