Gospel Reflection:

Today's gospel is taken from Luke. Jesus throws out this challenge to us



"... when you have a party, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; that they cannot pay you back means that you are fortunate, because repayment will be made to you when the virtuous rise again."

Catholic Social teaching is based on this challenge and these are the seven principles that underpin it

Life and Dignity of the Human Person.

Solidarity.

Care for God's creation.

Call to Family, Community and Participation.

Option for the Poor and Vulnerable.

Rights and Responsibilities.

Dignity of Work and Rights of Workers.

Who are the poor, the crippled, the lame or the blind in our world?

Fr Michael Tate suggests that "the majority of the poor and the crippled live in the subsistence villages, the refugee camps, and the squalor of the megacities of the Third World." This is the global perspective and deserving of our attention. Many service communities such as Caritas are working to assist in this area- we can help by supporting those communities.

The challenge is also to extend these principles to our own backyards- the homeless in our community, those with a disability, the sick, the lonely and the elderly. There are a number of examples of this in our Parish community- the work of J.A.G., school visits to Nixon House, Communion to the housebound to name a few.

Jesus himself provides the example. Luke's Jesus also always has a very open table for his dining. Welcome at Jesus' table is for everyone, rich and poor, men and women, all ages, races, ethnicities, religions and the ostracised. Jesus' point, ultimately, is not to deny our welcome to those closest to us but to extend our welcome to those whom others tend to forget or ignore.
