
Our readings for this week are: ISAIAH 53: 10-11; HEBREWS 4: 14-16; MARK 10: 35-45

Gospel Reflection:

The Gospel reading for today is challenging in a number of ways. It was certainly challenging for the disciples who were expecting their friend Jesus to stand against the authority of Rome and create for them a hierarchy of power. That was not the message that Jesus brought. There is certainly those questions posed by Jesus which James and John readily agree to.

'Can you drink the cup that I must drink, or be baptised with the baptism with which I must be baptised?'

With our knowledge of the life of Jesus we now realise that these questions are not as simple as saying we come to the table and we come to the waters of Baptism. This was Jesus asking his disciples to truly endure the challenges and torment he would face.



Often we are guilty of thinking like the disciples, that we too will have a guaranteed seat in heaven. Jesus challenges us to look beyond our own actions and be open to learning from each new experience and encounter, being humble in our approach and be open to the individual faith journey of each person. Like the sons of Zebedee, none of us should expect the 'special place' but there is a place for all. **Philip Hills**


