Our readings for this week are SIRACH 35: 12-14, 16-19; 2 TIMOTHY 4: 6-8, 16-18; LUKE 18: 9-14

Gospel Deflection:

This week's Gospel continues the teachings of Jesus about from week. prayer last describing the way the Pharisee and Tax Collector come to prayer, Jesus is giving a clear message about the need for humility in our lives and in our prayer. Being humble does not mean we hide or minimise our God-given gifts, talents or resources. It means we honour others by sharing them, enabling them to benefit from the goodness of God. As Micah 6:8



states the way to do this is to live justly, love tenderly and walk humbly with God.

At the conclusion of the gospel, in referring to the Tax Collector and his simple prayer, Jesus says "This man, I tell you, went home again at rights with God; the other did not." It raises the question- What does it mean to be at rights with God? This is a question that is at the forefront for our Year Three children in our parish as they prepare to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. By coming to the sacrament, we, like the Tax Collector, recognise that we are not in right relationship with others and with God and ask for God's forgiveness. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is the visible sign of God's mercy, forgiveness and love. May we have the Year Three children come to the sacrament trusting that with God's love and forgiveness they will at rights with God.
