Our readings for this week are: 1 SAMUEL 26:2,7-9,12-13,22-23; 1 CORINTHIANS 15:45-49; LUKE 6:27-38

Gospel Reflection:

Jesus said to his disciples, 'I say to you that listen,'

Listen! Listening is very difficult, I mean really listening, that deep listening with the ear of the heart. Our RCIA folk hear me say that all the time "listen with the ear of your heart", listen to what moves you deep inside where love and compassion live. This is what Jesus is talking about in today's Gospel and like ourselves the people Jesus was talking to were tied up with there own needs and desires. They wanted to be important and to be someone worth knowing as communities, and that meant having money, owning land, having people work for them, so Jesus really lays it



on thick, 'love you enemies, if some hits you ask them to hit you on the other side etc'.

This is a continuation from the sermon on the plane last week where Jesus comes down from the mount and sits with the people, 'sits with', not separate from or above them, but with them, in all his humanity he is with them and he speaks to them about loving one another, caring for each other, sharing what they have, looking after the sick and those who mourn.

No wonder in today's Gospel Jesus lays it on thick because so many of still don't get it! We don't won't to share our land, or even acknowledge the traditional owners, the poor have to wait for many months for a hospital bed for certain operations, or they get sent home well before they are well enough. The poor go to the doctors but can not afford the prescribed medicines. They sit in their homes cold, because they can't afford to run their heaters.

Can we listen to what Jesus is saying, really LISTEN, can we listen with the ear of the heart?


