# Pentecost Sunday - Year C - 8th & 9th June 2019

Our readings for this week are **ACTS 2: 1-11; ROMANS 1: 17-23; LUKE 24: 46-53** 

# **Gospel Deflection:**

Pentecost is called the birthday of the church because before Pentecost, there really was no church. Jesus had ascended back into the heavens, the Apostles were scared and confused, and nobody knew what to do. Going out to baptize people and preach about Jesus was the last thing they had in mind because their lives would be in danger.

But Pentecost celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit – the force that turned a group of frightened, mixed-up disciples and followers of Jesus into a church. There was a rush of wind, tongues of fire, and then suddenly there was courage, knowledge, direction and commitment! Everyone started speaking and were understood, no matter what the language of the listener was! These were saints suddenly on fire with the Holy Spirit.

What changes in you do you wish the Spirit could blow your way? How can you cooperate with the Spirit? In what ways do you need more courage, knowledge, direction commitment? What else might you need?

In what ways are you and our parish like the disciples before Pentecost? In what ways are you and our parish like the disciples after Pentecost?
