Dear Friends,

As I spent time in our Church this week I was struck by the deep links that connect our Parish to our Patron Saint, Thomas More. The relics and statues around the Church are a tangible sign of our communion with St Thomas More and of his unwavering commitment to justice and truth. They remind us of those men and woman whose courageous sacrifices have inspired our own faith. They offer us encouragement and inspiration in our vocation to holiness in our different states of life. This great calling was a central concern of the Second Vatican Council. The Council affirmed "All the faithful of Christ of whatever rank or status, are called to the fullness of the Christian life and to the perfection of charity" (LG40).

I am very excited to be appointed as Administrator of St Thomas More Parish. My inspiration as Pastor comes from Vatican II: to assist and enable each person to experience the fullness of Christian life, and to grow more in love of God and of neighbor. This mission is already well underway. After reading Journey of a Faith Community, I was impressed that our parish has a proud history of building up community, of supporting the poor and vulnerable, of adult faith formation and celebration of the sacraments. My hope and prayer is that we can continue to build upon all the good that has gone before us. I want to acknowledge the recent contribution of Fr Joe, who reached out in so many different ways to parishioners during a very difficult time and Fr Laurie whose priestly love and care for parishioners continues to bear much fruit. I am very grateful for all those who have continued to support the parish financially, practically and spiritually, especially throughout these months of transition and change

Now is the time to rebuild and recover from all that COVID-19 has wrought on our community. As we enter this phase of "COVID- Normal" I want to reaffirm that all are very welcome to join us for Masses and Sacraments at St Thomas More. We have space for 130 people at each Mass, and there is no need to pre-book, as contact details can be recorded upon entry. I look forward to meeting as many of you as I can in the coming weeks after Mass or around the parish, and working with our committees and parishioners to find opportunities to build up the community at gatherings and events throughout the year ahead.

Please pray for me, as I continue to remember you in my prayers, especially at the Altar of Praise.


