Thankyou for the warm welcome I've received so far at St Thomas More! It's been great getting to meet so many of you over the last few weeks, including representatives from the different parish groups working around Mt Eliza and beyond. Parishioners are rightly proud of their parish and have been keen to tell the story of where we began, how we got here and our hopes and dreams for the future.

Owing to COVID-19 I'm conscious that we haven't been able to gather as a whole community for some time, so work is currently underway to bring the whole parish together as circumstances allow. After nearly a year of restrictions it's been heartening to see parishioners meet reunite. To this end, there will be a tea, coffee and refreshments available after each of the Masses on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of February. All are very welcome to say hello and catch up as we begin this New Year.

You would have noticed in Seasons that we have been advertising over the last several weeks for volunteers to assist with running the A/V equipment at each of the Masses. I'm mindful that our Mass count remains subdued while some of our vulnerable parishioners are choosing to stay at home. Unfortunately we are still well short of finding enough parishioners to fill these rosters. Vicki, our Office Manager spends time each week on the phones trying to fill these slots. If gaps still remain by Saturday, Vicki has often filled in at Masses where parishioners are not available. Often, those volunteering to assist with A/V are also readers or commentators as well. While I'm very grateful for the generosity of all those who have helped us during this time, these efforts are not sustainable going forward as we need a reliable roster to operate the A/V for both sound and picture. A further consideration is the current advice from the Archdiocese on music at Mass. Because of the physical arrangement of our Church, current COVID-19 guidance means that no words or lyrics for songs are able to be projected onto the screens, which limits our ability to fully participate in the liturgical celebration.

As a temporary solution, from this week going forward, all the texts and responses for Sunday Masses will be printed in Seasons. Copies of the newsletter will be freely available as you enter the Church and should be taken with you when you leave. When the restrictions on music ease further and as more parishioners return and are available to volunteer, I hope to review this arrangement as soon as resources allow. Please let us know if you are able to volunteer in any capacity.
