

Dear friends,

There have been several changes to the appointment of the clergy in the Archdiocese over the last few months. There has also being a change to my appointment. Archbishop Peter Comensoli has appointed me as Chaplain to the Royal Melbourne Hospital and Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre, and part-time assistant priest to the parish of St Michael's, North Melbourne.

Some of you may know that one of my passions is to walk with people during their time of illness and suffering. The appointment as hospital chaplain is something that I have been waiting for in the last several years – finally, the opportunity has come.

The appointments as hospital chaplain and part-time assistant priest come into effect on 16 Dec 2020. Therefore, my last day at STM parish is 15 December 2020.

## **Assistance Required**

Due to building density and social distancing regulations, STM Church can only have a total of 65 attendees for each service (this figure could be doubled when the building density and social distancing rules are further eased by Christmas).

However, before STM Parish can start having 65 attendees at each Mass it is <u>necessary</u> that we have <u>at least</u> a team of 2 volunteers to assist with sanitising the Church after Mass. Also, we need 1 volunteer to supervise the registration process for each Mass. Ideally, we would need to have more than 1 team of volunteers to help with cleaning the Church and to supervise the registration process. ## NOTE!!!!!

We are trialling a QR (Quick Response) code that has been authorised by the Catholic Archdiocese. This is an alternative way to sign in as you come to Church—it is still preferable that you book your seat ahead of time with the Parish Office.

- 1. Hold the camera up to the code, so that it's all visible, and then a message will drop down from the top of the screen, asking if you want to **Open "asta-staysafe.com.au" in Safari**, or a similar banner will appear on an Android phone
- 2. Tap on the message/banner to open the St Thomas More Parish check in page in your browser. You only need to enter your first name and phone number, and submit.
- 3. If you're checking in for other members of your household who can be contacted on the same number, you can add all names in one hit, separated by commas.
- 4. If you're checking in on behalf of someone else who doesn't have a mobile, you can add their landline number in the contact number field.



# PPLT

#### SUMMARY OF MEETING 18.11.20

1. SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT- The committee was addressed by Julie Banda on behalf of John Natoli and the 4 other members of this group and viewed the video: 'What a Child Safe Parish Looks Like'. The following matters were then discussed:

- A Child Safety Policy and Code of Conduct has been compiled by the Safety Group

2. BUSINESS ARISING from last meeting: New Member drive for the PPLT. It was decided to use 'Seasons' to call for new members before the January meeting.

3. SCHOOL GOVERNANCE REPORT- J.Griffin showed a map of the property, which clearly delineates school, parish and shared areas, usage and responsibility for upkeep and management. Fr Joe discussed issues regarding the role of the parish priest, archdiocese and the school, as well as signing off the governance document.

4. CHRISTMAS MASSES: Fr Joe reported on his meeting with the Liturgy Team, who are unable to facilitate an outdoor children's Christmas Mass on the oval this year due to low membership numbers. Indoor mass will be held under COVID restrictions of 80-100 people maximum spaced throughout the church. There will be 2 Christmas masses this year:

- Christmas Eve- 7.45 for 8pm with one instrumentalist and one vocalist, a commentator and reader and two ministers of the Eucharist.

- Christmas Day Mass- 9am

5. COVID SAFE PRACTICES FOR WEEKEND MASSES- Discussion was held regarding the need for a COVID SAFE team to set up the Church and sanitise furniture and equipment before and after Mass. Fr Joe will organize a 'call out' for teams through 'Seasons'.

6. EMPLOYMENT OF A CATECHIST: Fr Joe reported on progress in this matter so far. Closing date for applications has been extended.

7. PPLT CHRISTMAS BREAK UP & FAREWELL FOR FR. JOE:

- As Fr Joe is leaving the parish on December 16<sup>th</sup>, his farewell will be held on Sunday, December 13<sup>th</sup> at the 10am Mass.

#### EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST- PPLT

The PPLT are currently under quota and so we are calling on all interested parishioners to put their hands up to join the PPLT. We meet in the evening on the 3rd Wednesday of each month to discuss, plan and implement activities that benefit the whole parish community. During this difficult year we have met via Zoom meetings but usually we meet in the Parish House

Please consider joining the PPLT. This represents us, the people of our community and it's where our voices can be heard. We are an advisory group to the Parish Priest/ Administrator and we work together with the best interests of this Parish in mind. At the centre of our meetings is the Parish three year Plan (which is due for an update) and decisions are made within this framework.
