 - 3. Pilgrimage Service at 2pm meeting at the Parish Office, then proceeding to the Memorial Wall, concluding at the Church
- Any time during the 40th celebration year. Please note that the private residence at Grey Friars and Morningstar will only be available on Feb 9th.
- <u>Private Reflection</u> you may use the booklet at any time for private reflection and prayer during our 40th year celebration

If you are intending to walk next Saturday don't forget to

consider how you will get back to our starting point. There is ample parking at the beach and the parish..... perhaps find a friend to car pool and organise a shuttle with – e.g. one car at the beach and one at the Parish! There will also be drivers available to help, especially if you find you can only do part of the walk.



St Thomas More's School Community Pathway

The School Parents Association are very excited to announce that starting from Term I 2019, they will be taking orders for personalised, engraved bricks, which will be used to create a special STM Community Pathway going from the new playgrounds to the school oval. Past and present students are invited to add their names to the Community Pathway by purchasing a brick paver for each child, or one for the whole family. The bricks will be engraved and placed along that pathway to link students from the past, present and future. It is a fantastic way to mark your family's time at STM Primary School and will create a lasting connection for your child to the school.

Baptisms

These are held on the 1st & 3rd Sundays of each month at 11:15 am or at any of the Parish Masses on the 2nd, 4th or 5th Sundays. A compulsory preparation night for parents takes place on the first Tuesday of each month in the Parish Community Centre at 7:30 pm. The next Baptism Preparation Evening will be held on the 5th February 2019. Children to be baptised, and their families, are then invited to a Welcome Mass prior to Baptism where they are

introduced to the Parish Community and welcomed by them. In order for this to happen, preparation needs to begin at least <u>4-6 weeks</u> before the Baptism, with a call to confirm parents' attendance at the Preparation Night. When children of school age are to be baptised an extended preparation time is required.

It is important to remember that Baptism is about the initiation of a child into a community of Faith or a community of Disciples. There is no such thing as a 'private' Baptism... it is something done by the whole Church.
