**AUSTRALIAN CATHOLIC YOUTH FESTIVAL 2019** 

This is the Melbourne Pilgrimage Appeal Weekend at all parishes in the Archdiocese of Melbourne.



It is in support of young Melbourne Catholics attending the Australia Catholic Youth Festival (ACYF) -Australia's largest Catholic youth event—to be held in Perth from Sunday 8 to Tuesday 10 December.

Under the theme of "Listen to what the Spirit is Saying", the Festival provides an important opportunity for young people to gather and celebrate the vitality of the Church in Australia. Youth engagement is a special priority of Archbishop Peter and a large group from Melbourne will attend.
