Walk Of Witness - Led By Bishop Mark **Edwards OMI**

The Walk of Witness will commence in Federation Square at 12.30pm on Tuesday, 18th September with the Parable of the Good Samaritan.

At Ipm the Walk will proceed from Federation Square to St Patrick's Cathedral, with a stop on the Steps of the Victorian Parliament (approx. 1.45pm), arriving at St Patrick's Cathedral at 2pm, where Bishop Mark will officially launch the Statement for the Archdiocese of Melbourne (a total distance of 1.15km).

This walk of Witness is an action of solidarity with the thousands of people who are homeless and for the many others for whom dignified housing is becoming an unrealised dream.


All are welcome to participate, and to bring school / parish / organisation banners, as we proceed through the streets of one of the world's most liveable cities.
