# St Vincent de Paul Society

The St Vincent de Paul Society has set aside this Sunday as the day to say Thank you.

Thank you to all the parishioners around the state of Victoria who have given So generously to the Society. This generosity covers Parish Priests like Fr Laurie who give their whole hearted support to the society's work, to the people who support our appeals, to those who quietly put money in the Poor Box, donate toys to our Christmas Appeal, give goods or volunteer their time at our Vinnies stores. It all helps to provide the resources we need to assist those less fortunate in our society. Our main work is visitation and last year our Conference alone spent over \$105,000 in food vouchers, Chemist scripts, furniture, education, clothing, rent assistance and household goods.
