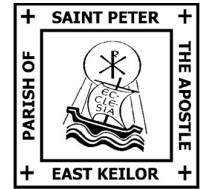

Responsorial Psalm

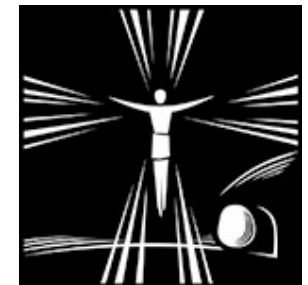
