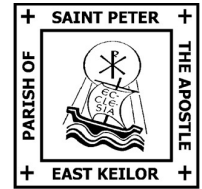

### FATHER'S DAY APPEAL- COLLECTION FOR RETIRED AND SICK PRIESTS 'Caring for those who cared' – 31 August/1 September

This weekend the annual Father's Day collection will be taken up for the support of the Priests' Retirement Foundation. Envelopes are available. Donations over \$2 re tax deductible. Please support generously.

Today, the Foundation in conjunction with the Archdiocese of Melbourne, cares for about 90 retired priests. Most have served 50 years in parish ministry before retiring at age 75. There will be an average of 6 retirements expected per year for the next 6 years. It will cost the Foundation \$3m annually, to support these priests in various places and in varying degrees of care, from low care to high care.
