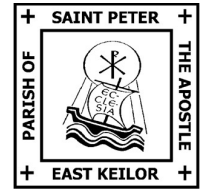

- Ash Wednesday is a day of special prayer and penance. Mass is an excellent way to begin Lent.

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting and Abstinence.
- Fasting – means being moderate in what we eat and applies to those over 18 and not yet 60.
