Kept in the Roman Church since the fifth century, they are observed in Australia on the first Fridays of Autumn and Spring (March and September) as special days of prayer and penance.

- Ember days seek God's blessing of favourable weather and a fruitful harvest from the land, interceding in times of drought or flood and giving thanks in better times.
- There is a strong impulse on these days towards the justice of God's kingdom, with attention given to those peoples who are devastated by famine and exploitation.
- Ember days rightly focus on the environment, climate change, and our stewardship of the world's resources. Doing penance reminds us that sustainable use of our resources will cost us in our attitudes and lifestyle.
