THE SEASON OF LENT

The Season of Lent, has a twofold character:

- * it recalls our Baptism and the promises undertaken.
- * it stresses a penitential spirit.

Lent is a timer of penance, when we are exhorted to devote ourselves in a special manner to prayer, to engage in works of piety and charity, and to deny ourselves.

By these means especially, Lent readies us for celebrating the Paschal Mystery (Easter) after a period of closer attention to the Word of God, and prayerful reflection.

Good Friday is a day of Fasting and Abstinence from meat.

All who have completed their 18th year and have not begun their 60th year are bound to fast. All who have completed their 14th year are bound to abstain.

On all other Fridays, the we are called to perform one of the following:

Prayer: For example:- Mass attendance, family prayer, making the Stations of the Cross.

Self-denial: For example:- not eating meat, not eating sweets, giving up entertainment, limiting food and drink, supporting Project Compassion.

Helping Others: For example:- special attention to those in need, sick, poor, elderly.

<u>Project Compassion Boxes and Envelope Packs</u> are available, for our use during Lent, in the porches of the Church. Another way of making a sacrifice during Lent.
