HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE ST VINCENT DE PAUL ANNUAL REPORT 2015

St Vincent de Paul Society

The Strathmore Conference of the St Vincent de Paul Society provides 'person to person' practical assistance to those experiencing social isolation and economic disadvantage through home visits, distributing food and enabling access to 'free of charge' resources such as furniture, clothing and household goods. Support is also provided to households through access to pharmaceutical products, education support and recognition of hardships experienced through rising utility costs. During the 2014-15 financial year the Strathmore Conference undertook 160 home visits, providing assistance to 306 adults and 268 children in the Strathmore Parish and wider community, including asylum seekers and refugee households. The Conference distributed over \$63,000 in material aid to those need. The Conference meets monthly and currently has eight Conference members and three Associate members, and enjoys strong support from parishioners through their generous donations of quality clothing, furniture and household goods to people in need.
